Drinking Water Strategically

Start your day with a glass of water to replenish fluids lost overnight and boost metabolism and continue sipping water throughout the day rather than waiting until you feel thirsty, as thirst can lag behind actual dehydration levels. Carry a water bottle you enjoy using to encourage regular intake, and consider infusing water with fruits, vegetables, or herbs for flavor and added nutrients. Aim for roughly 8–13 cups of fluids daily, adjusting for activity, heat, and personal needs.
